That God directs us to his perfect will in outreach to our community. We are considering Habitat for Humanity, Servants, and other options to improve service opportunities by mixing our people with the community.

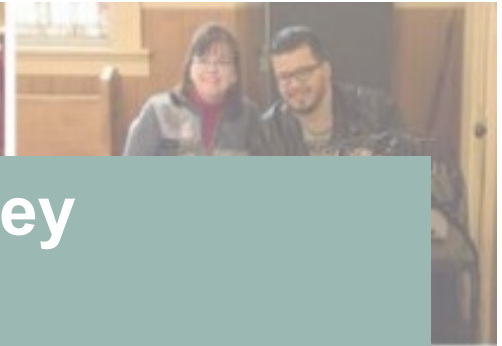

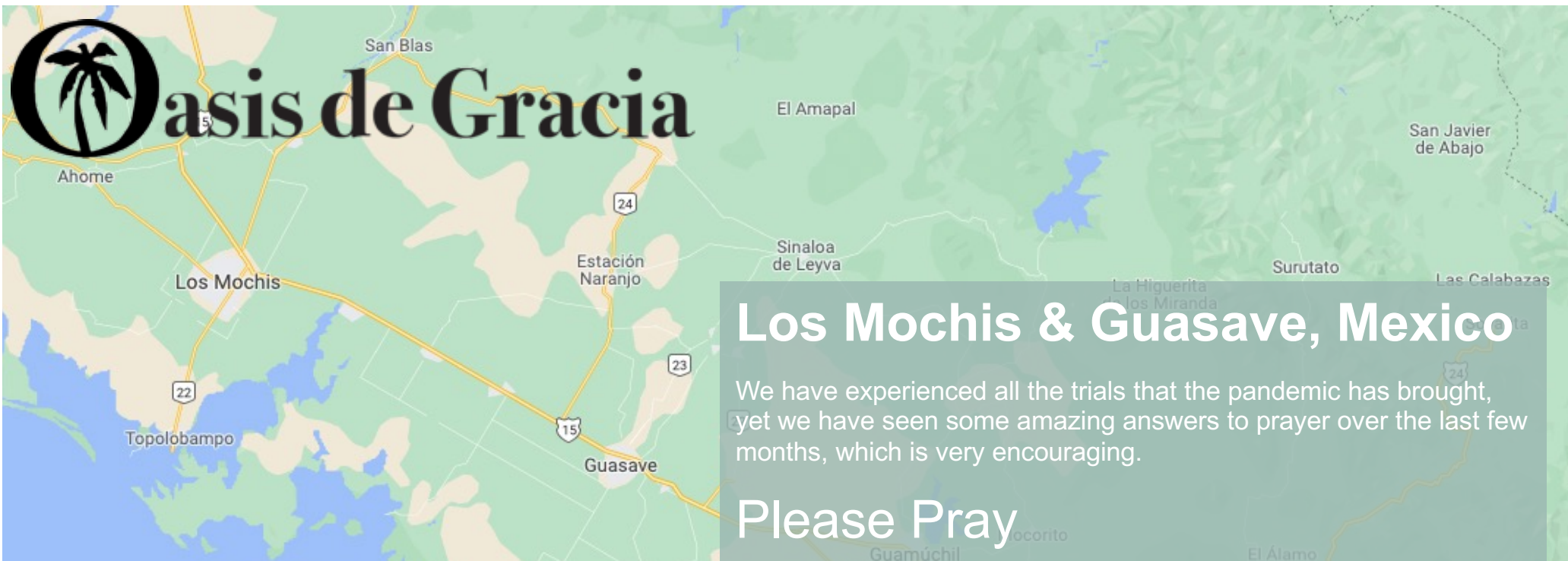
